CIRCULAR

Rajasthan is a Water scarce State and per capita availability of Water is decreasing day by day due to increasing population and climate change. It is estimated that within next 20 years, the State may come in the category of absolute scarcity which would be a serious set-back for the development of the State. Therefore, it is imperative to take all necessary steps to conserve and efficient use of available Water resources to ensure its sustainability. Integrated Water Management Planning is an effective tool to achieve the objective:

2. In this context, it has been decided to prepare Integrated Water Management Plans for each Distt. in the State. The Plans would be prepared by the concerned departments for each village which would be integrated at block and district levels. The Plans would be prepared in consultation with the PRI's and the people. SE WRD would be the co-ordinating officer for preparation of the district IWRM Plan. A committee consisting of the following is constituted to coordinate the work: -

- 1. SE WRD
- 2. SE PHED/ Ex.En PHED
- 3. Ex.En. Water Shed
- 4. Sr.Hydrologist/ Hydrologist GWD

- Convener
- Member
- Member
- Member

3. This Committee will ensure that the village and block level Plans of their sectors are prepared as per the guidelines given in the enclosed tamplet. At the village level the Jr.Engineer of the Water Resources Deptt and Jr.Engineer PHED would prepare the Plan in consultation with the Panchayat and the people. The village level Plans would be consolidated at district level by the Asst. Engineer PHED and Asstt.Engineer WRD and will be submitted to SE WRD. The above Committee would finalise the District Plan and submit it to the Chief Engineer Water Resources as per schedule annexed with this letter. All the activities are to be completed as per the enclosed Schedule.

4. Training: -

The training of the officers for preparing these Plans would be held at IMTI Kota. It will be compulsory for the officers nominated for the training to attend these trainings. At IMTI Kota, training of District Training Team consisting of SE WRD, SE PHED and Sr.Hydrologist/ Hydrologist of the GWD and Ex.En. Watershed would be held. This District Team would further train the District

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level and field officers in each district so that this work is completed on Schedule.

5. Funds for preparation of Plans: -

Funds for preparation of Plans and Training would be allocated from EC SPP by Chief Engineer SWRPD. The amount for each district could be worked out keeping in the requirements. Chief Engineer WR would intimate the district wise requirement of funds to CE SWRPD. All concerned are requested to ensure that the time lines laid down are followed and the Plans are ready by end of December, 2009.

6. CE (WR) would be the nodal officer at State level to ensure preparation of these plans as per Scheme.
