ORDER

In partial modification of the order No. 6(10)/AR/Sec-3/2009 dated 30.5.2011; as per provision laid down in the Common Guidelines for Watershed Development Projects issued by Department of Land Resources, Ministry of Rural Development, GOI, New Delhi w.e.f. 01.04.2008, the revised sanction of His Excellency, the Governor of State of Rajasthan is here by issued for the constitution of State Level Nodal Agency (SLNA).

The main functions of the SLNA will be as under :-

- a) To sign an MoU with the Ministry / Departmental Nodal Agency setting out mutual expectations with regard to performance, time lines and financial parameters.
- b) Prepare a Perspective & Strategic Plan of Watershed Development for the State on the basis of plans prepared at the block and district level and indicate implementation strategy and expected outputs/outcomes, financial outlays and approach the Nodal Agency at the Central level in the Department for appraisal and clearance.
- c) Sanction the Watershed Projects for the State on the basis of approved State Perspective & Strategic Plan.
- d) Establish and maintain a State Level Data Cell from the funds sanctioned to the States, and connect it online with the National Level Data Centre.
- e) Provide technical support to District Watershed Development Units (DWDU) throughout the State.
- f) Approve a list of independent institutions for capacity building of various stakeholders within the State and work out the overall capacity building strategy in consultation with NRAA/Nodal Ministry.
- g) Approve Project Implementing Agencies identified / selected by DWDU/District Level Committee by adopting appropriate objective selection criteria and transparent systems.
- h) Establish monitoring, evaluation and learning systems at various levels (internal and external/independent systems).
- i) Ensure regular and quality on-line monitoring of watershed projects in the State in association with Nodal Agency at the Central level.
- j) Constitute a panel of Independent Institutional Evaluators for all watershed projects within the State, get this panel duly approved by the concerned Nodal Agencies at the Central level and ensure that quality evaluations take place on a regular basis.
- k) Prepare State Specific Process Guidelines, Technology Manuals etc. in co-ordination with the Nodal Ministry/NRAA and operationalize the same.

Director of Watershed Development & Soil Conservation will act as office of CEO, SLNA which will include team of experts for providing support to SLNA as per Common Guidelines.

The Department of Rural Development & Panchayati Raj Government of Rajasthan would be the Administrative Department of SLNA.
