
विषय:- वर्ष 2009-10 एवं 2010-11 की डीपीआर का एसएलएनए से अनुमोदन।





Madam,

Above proposals of DPR of IWMP projects (year 2010-11) have been examined. It is found that storage of the proposed structures is not adversely affecting the storage of existing water bodies. Hence, this office has no objection if these structures are being taken up. However, the % age of runoff tapped in Sahibi basin (DPR no. Alwar 6) is comparatively on higher side hence it may be reviewed. Accordingly, storage of proposed structures should be proportionately reduced.
