2. The interventions suggested in the DPR have logical correlation with preliminary data.
3. The DPR is as per Common Guidelines and circulars issued by Department from time to time especially budgetary provisions under different components and the beneficiary contribution.
4. Water budgeting is part of DPR.
5. The cost and estimates are as per GKN/ BSR and existing norms of line departments like agriculture, horticulture, animal husbandry, forest etc.

6. The measures proposed are technically viable as per the thematic layers and justified in the DPR.
 7. All necessary maps are enclosed in DPR.
 8. Livelihood plan.
 9. Annual Action Plan.
